Superintendent's Recommendations

1. <u>Dispensing with Statutory Bidding Procedures Due to Conditions of Urgent Necessity</u> and Approving the Construction Contract

It is recommended the resolution listed below regarding dispensing with statutory bidding procedures due to conditions of urgent necessity be approved as submitted.

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Warren City School District (the "Board") desires to immediately undertake various structural and safety upgrades to the Willard PK-8 School Building, including replacement of the roof (the "Project"), to ensure the safety of students, staff and visitors and the structural integrity of the building; and

WHEREAS, the Board must immediately commence work on the Project so that it can continue with necessary school building operations and preparation for the 2020-2021 school year; and

WHEREAS, compliance with the procedures for the advertisement of bids prescribed by Ohio Revised Code section 3313.46 will unduly delay the Project and threaten the normal operations of the Board and the health, safety and welfare of students, staff and visitors.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code section 3313.46, it is found and determined that there is an urgent necessity and need for entering into a contract for the Project.
- Section 2. It is further found and determined that compliance with the bidding procedure contained in Ohio Revised Code section 3313.46 would unduly delay the Project, which would threaten the normal operations of the Board and be contrary to the health, safety and welfare of students served by the Board as well as staff and visitors.
- Section 3. The Superintendent and Executive Director of Business Operations have received quotes for the Project and have recommended that the Board accept the quote of Boak &Sons, Inc., which quote is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- Section 4. The Board hereby accepts and approves the quote and the Agreement with Boak & Sons, Inc. and authorizes the Superintendent to execute the Agreement.

- Section 5. The Board hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board; and that all deliberations of this Board and its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 6. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its adoption and shall supersede any prior resolution or act of this Board which may be inconsistent with or duplicative of this resolution.
