My name is Mike Davidson and I am the Warren City School District Supervisor of Aquatics. We are implementing a new program for the 6th graders that will help us to continue building on the current 5th grade learn to swim program and will also enable us to continue helping the students in the WCSD to enhance their water safety development!

We have set aside one week dates that will allow each 6th grade class in the school district to come to the pool and have a refresher course of their previous 5th grade learn to swim experience. We will review Water Safety and refresh the freestyle and backstroke for each child. Our goal is to develop water safety as a top priority and then to encourage any of our students that have an interest in developing their swimming capabilities to swim on the Warren Middle School Swim Team for 7th and 8th graders.

McGuffey will attend: Tuesday, February 20 through Friday, February 23 and Monday February 26; class times will be 9:45-10:45, 11:00-12:00 & 12:00-1:00. Students will be assigned a group based on their first core content class. Students must wear appropriate swim attire: girls will wear a 1-piece bathing suit and boys shorts must have a drawstring. Students must bring their own towel, but we have limited towels and suits if needed. Good behavior and safety is our top priority!

We are very excited to offer this new program and continue the Water Safety Education for Warren City School Students!

The day for Family Visitation will be the 4^{th} class meeting for the week, Friday, February 23. There will be a handout and 2 tickets per student given to the teacher of each class.
