College Credit Plus

- Replaces PSEO
- Replaces dual enrollment



Opportunity to Earn College Credit

- Grades 7 12
- College-ready students
- Many college course options
- Public colleges are free
- Private colleges may include small cost



Apply and Get Admitted

Participate by getting admitted into a college.

May have to take a placement test and other criteria.





Graduate with College Credit


Earn up to **30 college credit** hours per academic year; summer not included.

No more than **120 college credit hours** while in the program.

Upon the successful completion of courses, students will receive final grades posted in two places; (1) high school transcript and (2) college transcript.



Under what scenarios can a qualified student use College Credit Plus?



You want to take college courses to satisfy your high school graduation requirements.

You completed your high school graduation required classes and you want to begin college work.

You want to explore college and take a course in a subject that interests you.

What About Extra-Curricular Participation?

 College Credit Plus students are eligible to participate in extra & co-curricular activities such as band and athletics, if their course schedule permits.

Note: Student Athletes must still satisfy eligibility criteria set forth by the Ohio High School Athletic Association

A Few Points of Note

- This is not college credit for high school coursework. It is taking college courses while in high school
- Assess student's level of preparedness& maturity
- When does it make sense for you to pursue this?
- Consider long-term goals and interests



Benefits of College Credit Plus

- Provides more options for rigorous curriculum beyond HS
- Earn college credit while in HS (can potentially complete your freshman year of college or more)
- Explore college content
- Assigned an academic counselor
- Reduce time and costs of attending college after HS
- Gain college experience while in HS



Risks College Credit Plus

- Impact on HS GPA and class standing
- Permanent College GPA classes failed or w/d will receive an "F" on HS & college transcripts & will be computed into the HS GPA/rank
- Increased travel & study
- Increased academic rigor & responsibility for learning
- Conflicts between HS & college schedules
