- Students should create only 1 user name and password for the Collegboard site. Multiple
  accounts will impact registration in the future and the release of results. Students are
  responsible for maintaining their login information. Scores will be issued to student accounts
  prior to the school receiving results.
- Each student is eligible for <u>2 waivers</u>. These are used one in the junior year and one in the senior year. Any additional attempts are paid by the student/family with a credit card.
- Each student can send up to 4 universities their SAT score for each test administration—
  additional universities can be added for a fee. Students planning on participating in College
  Athletics should send their score to the NCAA Eligibility Center (Code #: 9999).
- Scores will be included on the Harding transcript if Harding is chosen as the student high school
   (CEEB Code: 365 335). Many universities will use these scores. See university admission webpage to see if they require a direct report from ACT. Direct Report means that the scores MUST come from the ACT, not Harding.
- Students wanting to participate in College Credit Plus for the 2018-19 school year are encouraged to take the December test.
- If you have an IEP/504 Plan you must notify that you receive accommodations when you register for the test.
