

# **WGH College Credit Plus Checklist for the 2018-19**

## **School Year (With tentative dates listed)**

- 1) \_\_\_\_\_ Complete the College Credit Plus Student Survey Link:  
<https://goo.gl/forms/QbVXR7xkizvzkWw2> (Week of January 29-Feb. 7<sup>th</sup>)
- 2) \_\_\_\_\_ Complete & Turn in an **Intent to Participate form** (Completed annually by April 1<sup>st</sup>)
- 3) \_\_\_\_\_ Complete the **College Credit Plus Application** for each university you are interested in taking courses from. We have target dates where a rep will walk you through the process. Our building goal is complete our applications in February (deadlines are actually later).
  - a. \_\_\_\_\_ YSU (February 8<sup>th</sup>—students will be called in about 20 at a time)—Make-ups will be held with Mrs. Kampf-Melillo.
  - b. \_\_\_\_\_ ECGG (Feb 13<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> )
  - c. \_\_\_\_\_ Kent-Trumbull (Feb 13<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> )
  - d. \_\_\_\_\_ Kent- Main (Feb 13<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> )
- 4) \_\_\_\_\_ Complete & Turn in an **Parent Consent form** for each university that you plan to apply
- 5) \_\_\_\_\_ Complete the Campus Education Plan for each university that you plan to attend class ON THEIR CAMPUS.
- 6) \_\_\_\_\_ Print a set of each ACT/SAT Test scores for Mrs. Kampf-Melillo—for any test taken after the February ACT.----See additional steps for students who did not reach college readiness standards in Math, Reading, & English.
- 7) \_\_\_\_\_ Activate your student accounts once you receive and email or letter from each university to which you applied.
- 8) \_\_\_\_\_ Store your user name in password to each of these account in multiple locations.
- 9) \_\_\_\_\_ Check your email **weekly for each university**. Placement test information and official communication will be sent to your university email account.
- 10) \_\_\_\_\_ Attend Orientation at YSU & Kent (On-line with EGCC) –We will have firm dates shortly.

## **What happens if a student does not reach College Readiness Standards on the ACT/SAT?**

- 1) ACT: 17 COMPOSITE
  - a. Reading: 22**
  - b. Math: 22**
  - c. English: 18****
- 2) If you attain the composite & one of the readiness standards—you will enter the appeals process.**
- 3) To enter the appeals process, a student must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA at the time of admissions (February 2018) and a recommendation from Mrs. Kampf-Melillo.**
- 4) Students will then have to take placement tests determined by the university to meet the course requirements.**
- 5) There are deadlines for placement testing. Information is typically dispersed by the university by way of student university email to communicate the process.**
